Subject: Revised Request for Proposals (RFP) for Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) – Water and Electric Meters for the City of Gastonia and Two Rivers Utilities Service Area - Addendum 1.

The following answers are provided to questions received since the release date of 3/11/24 through 3/18/24. The City will continue to try to issue weekly addenda with answers to questions received to be responsive to Vendors and to best accommodate the condensed timeline.

- 1. Would Gastonia please extend the due date? Three weeks is a short time frame to prepare a response or even revise a previous one. This is especially true for acquiring an up-to-date propagation study from a meter manufacturer.
 - a. Yes. The deadline to submit proposals has been extended two weeks to: Tuesday, April 16, 2024 at 4:00 pm EDT

RFP documents #1 and #2 have been updated in the file share to reflect this change.

- 2. For the proposal due date and time, should it indicate 4:00pm EDT instead of EST?
 - a. Yes, since Daylight Savings Time has passed, the proposals are due at 4:00 pm EDT on April 16, 2024.
- 3. Since many of the AMI providers for water and electric DO NOT manufacture their own water meter, will the City accept a proposal for encoded water meters only from a distributor?
 - a. The City is seeking a comprehensive solution that includes water meters, electric meters and a single AMI network that supports both water and electric services. The City is open to a water or electric meter manufacturer working with a third-party AMI solution. Any limitations to interoperability, such as receiving extended alarms or over-the-air updates, should be clearly specified.
