Temporary Power Qualifications, Conditions and Penalty Statement

By making application through our CityView Portal you agree to the following:

****NOTE TO POWER COMPANY****

Do NOT take power out of contractor's name until notified by City Inspections Department

PURPOSE:

To assist contractors in completing constructions of commercial and residential buildings by providing a means of supplying sufficient electrical power to operate furnaces for heating the structure sufficiently, to permit installation of floor and wall coverings, or to provide power to operate equipment for testing purposes.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The structure must be under roof and permanent exterior walls must be in place. Windows and doors must be installed. All equipment must be in place and ready for operation.
2. All rough inspections must be made and approved. Service equipment must be installed and inspected. All electrical switches and receptacles must be installed.
3. Final inspections on heating system must be made and approved. Applies if heating system is to be connected.

CONDITIONS:

1. Temporary power will be granted for one hundred twenty (120) days only.
2. Power must be in the name of the person who secured the permit. Power will not be changed until a Certificate of Compliance or Occupancy has been issued.
3. Application on Portal submitted by the Contractor/Permit Holder per application as needed.
4. There is a \$ 52.50 charge, payable at time of application, to have temporary power processed and turned on upon passing inspections loaded for this permit.
5. Conditions and qualifications as stated on the application for temporary service must be adhered to.
6. This conditional electric service is being given as a convenience for the Contractor/Permit Holder. Violations, such as occupancy or use of power for purposes other than being requested in this application, will be considered sufficient cause for the power to be terminated, as well as denial of future applications for the Contractor/Permit Holder as per penalties listed below:

PENALTY:

First Violation: \$250.00 Fine
Fine must be paid and a Certificate of Compliance or Occupancy must be obtained before any new permit or future temporary power granted.

Second Violation: \$500.00 Fine
Fine must be paid and a Certificate of Compliance or Occupancy must be obtained before any new Building Permits are issued. No future temporary power will be granted. In addition, the Inspections Division will notify the General Contractor's Licensing Board for possible reprimand.

By applying on portal and submitting your application, you agree with the procedure outlined here and will abide by the conditions and qualifications under which it is issued. You further agree that failure to comply with this procedure will result in the loss of future temporary power privileges for the owner, occupant, or contractor. The applicants making request for temporary service, hereby assume all liability for damages, which may occur due to electric power being connected.
